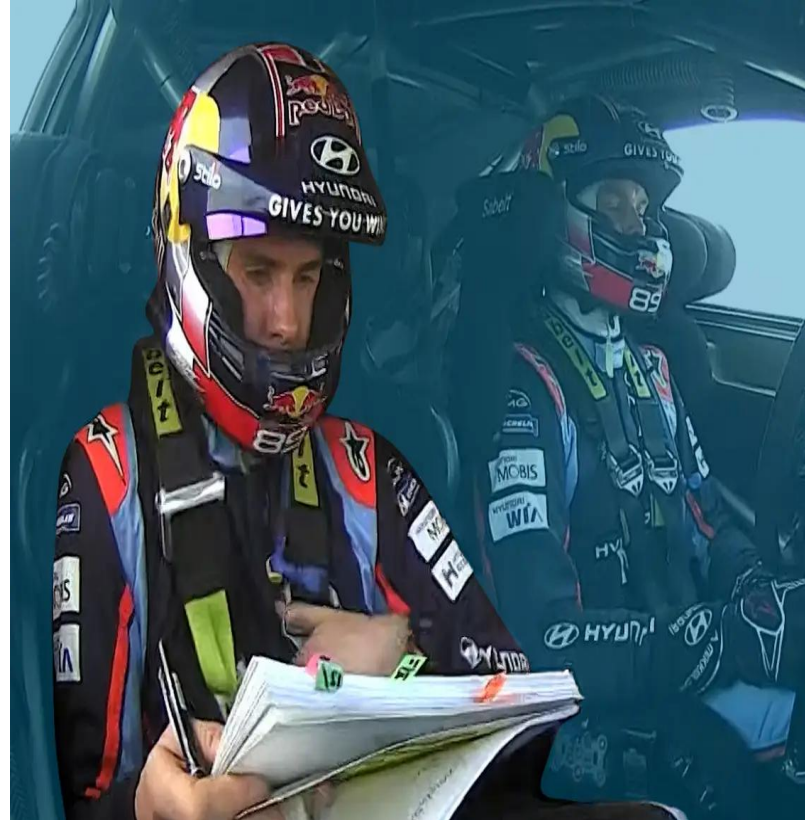

School Schedule & Procedures

- ✓ Arrival at school: Students to go to the Pitch

School Schedule & Procedures

- ✓ **NO Mobile/technological devices school policy applies. Random spot checks will be carried out. Unauthorised mobiles will be confiscated. Circular DES 07/2023**
- ✓ **Confiscated mobiles will be handed to parent/guardians and not to the student.**
- ✓ **Cyberbullying and any other offences on social media happen after school hours. Cyberbullying should be reported directly to the Police and not to the School/SMT. Since students are under the age of 13, they should not have any social media account/s.**
- ✓ **Monitor your child at home. Set boundaries for use of mobiles/laptop/tablets at home.**
- ✓ **Students may go to their Form teacher/guidance teacher/Deputy Head as required.**
- ✓ **Classes are mainly arranged according to choice of foreign language, Religion or Ethics, Music or Sports programme & benchmark results.**

MOVEMENT IN BETWEEN LESSONS

- ▶ Students move between lessons for different subjects.
- ▶ Students must walk on the **GREEN PATH** when crossing blocks.
- ▶ Works going on, on the new football ground- gates to be closed during change of lessons and breaks.
- ▶ Students must walk on the left side- of corridors. Corridors are divided with grey tape.
- ▶ **NO LOITERING.**
- ▶ **NO PUSHING.**
- ▶ **NO FIGHTING.**



Exam results, school communication & SSCP activities

- ▶ After-school activities can be written down in the SSCP form to be listed down in the school-leaving certificate. **SLC Number- DQSE**
- ▶ **THE SCHOOL DOES NOT HAVE AN INSTAGRAM ACCOUNT.**
- ▶ Half-yearly and Annual results are published online on MySchool.
- Annual exams in Humanities, Religion & Ethics may be done in English or Maltese. **Books of Maths, Maltese and English will be given by the school according to student tracks once school starts.**



School Transport

- ▶ **School transport is a concession and not a right!**
- ▶ **Students must keep same seating.**
- ▶ **Bullying, fighting, vulgar language and throwing of things on and out of the bus may lead to suspension of using transport.**
- ▶ **Driver must not be disturbed AT ALL TIMES. Safety during transport is a PRIORITY.**
- ▶ **Pick up points and bus routes will be sent from Education Department in due course. No unauthorised change of bus.**
- ▶ **Form Teachers will be informing students of their transport designated area in school. Good behaviour whilst waiting.**



School Tuck Shop & Lockers

- ▶ School tuck shop will be open in the morning before assembly and during break.
- ▶ **Lunch best prepared at home. Include a fruit and/or vegetables and a bottle of water.**
- ▶ **NO SOFT DRINKS OR ENERGY DRINKS.**
- ▶ Water fountains will be in use. Students must have their own bottle.
- ▶ Special fundraising events including special food events are in plan for this scholastic year.
- ▶ Small padlock for locker - Extra key with name & class to be brought by students.
- ▶ 3 Locker times per day.



Important to keep in mind

- ▶ The school is made up of 5 blocks. **It is important students carry an extra pair of socks and an umbrella so as not to get wet when changing blocks.**
- ▶ **Parents are to monitor their child preparing their school bag so only books/files required for the next day are placed in the bag.** This is in line with the school's anti-heavy school bag policy.
